Appendix - I

Admission Rules

i) Eligibility

- The student seeking admission should have secured at least 60% marks in class XII or an equivalent examination. For SC / ST / PD categories, the eligibility is at least 55% marks. For Central/State Boards using a 10-point scale, these would correspond to CGPA of 6.0 and 5.5, respectively.
- The student seeking admission to NISER and UM-DAE CEBS for the integrated MSc programme 2017-22 should be from regular science stream only and preferably should have any combination of at least three subjects among Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics in class XI and XII.
- The student must have passed class XII examination or equivalent from any recognized Board in India in the years 2015 or 2016 or appeared for the same in 2017.
- The student should have been born on or after 1st August 1997. For SC/ST/PD candidates the age limit is relaxed by 5 years.
- Students under the J&K quota should have the domicile certificate and must have passed the class XII examination from J&K State Board or CBSE affiliated school located in J&K.
- It is the responsibility of the student to ensure that the above criteria have been met and UM- DAE CEBS will not be held responsible for later disqualification of the student not satisfying any of these requirements.

ii) Documents and Admission Fees

The following documents have to be submitted, (2 self-attested photocopy of each plus the original certificate), at the time of admission. The original certificate will be returned after verification.

- Class X mark list
- Class XII mark list
- Class XII passing certificate
- School Leaving / College Leaving Certificate/Transfer Certificate
- Caste Certificate (if applicable)
- Non-Creamy Layer Certificate issued on or after June 1, 2016 (in case of OBC candidates – if applicable)
- Disability Certificate from Govt./Municipal hospital (in case of PD candidates)
- Domicile Certificate (for J&K quota)
- *Demand Draft of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) in favor of UM-DAE CBS, Mumbai towards initial payment of fees.
- Two self-attested photocopies of the following documents has to be submitted at the time of admission:
 - Proof of Citizenship / PIO / OCI card (applicable only if born outside India)
 - Proof of Date of Birth (applicable only if DoB is not mentioned in any of the documents above)

All category certificates should be written in either English or Hindi. In case certificates are written in any other language, a translated copy – in English or Hindi - must also be provided.

Students will be given a receipt of acknowledgement of admission.

iii) Cancellation

- a) Any student seeking cancellation of admission must do so by writing a signed letter addressed to the Registrar, UM-DAE CEBS, Prefabs, Annabhau Sathe Bhavan, University of Mumbai, Vidyanageri, Mumbai 400098, or through e-mail addressed to info@cbs.ac.in. The letter/email must be accompanied by the receipt of acknowledgement issued by UM-DAE CEBS to the students. The letter must specify the mode by which the certificate should be returned to the student. If any student requests return of original Migration Certificate by post / courier, UM-DAE CEBS will not be held responsible for any loss / delay / damage caused in this process.
- b) If a student cancels his / her admission on or before 20th July, he / she will be eligible for refund of the entire amount paid (minus the administrative fee of Rs. 500/-).
- c) If a student cancels his / her admission after 20th July but on or before 30th July, he / she will be eligible for refund of Rs. 9000/- only.
- d) Any student who cancels his/her admission on or after 31st July will not be entitled to any refund of the amount paid.

iv) Reservation and Number of seats

UM-DAE CEBS adopts the Government of India reservation policy for admission. The total number of seats can vary from year to year depending upon the infrastructure available.

- a. For this batch of 2017-18, at UM-DAE CEBS, there are 22 general seats, 12 seats for OBCs, 7 for SC, and 3 for ST. 1 seat is reserved for person with disability making the total number of seats available as 45. Two seats (supranumeral) are reserved for students from Jammu and Kashmir, India.
- b. In the event the seats for OBC students remain vacant after exhausting the corresponding list, they would be offered to General Category students.
- c. Seats not getting filled from SC / ST pool will remain vacant.

Appendix - II

General Rules

Please note that this is a residential 5-year integrated M.Sc. programme without an exit option for the B.Sc degree. For students admitted to the UM-DAE CEBS, stay in the Centre's hostel is mandatory. Upon successful completion of the course, a BSc degree will also be awarded along with the MSc degree.

i) Scholarship

- a) As per the revised guidelines of Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India and the Department of Atomic Energy, students are eligible for a monthly scholarship of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) in the first year.
- b) Continuation of the scholarship is determined by rules decided by DST at that point in time. At present, they require that the scholar shall pass (i) in all subjects, and (ii) secure minimum 60% aggregate marks or 6.0 CGPA on a point scale or its equivalent in his/her annual examinations (or 2 semesters) in B.Sc. / B.S. / Int. M.Sc. / Int. M.S. or M.Sc. examinations, failing which the scholarship for the next academic year will not be awarded.
- c) If a scholar has failed or could not attend the annual/ final / any of the semester examination(s) in that year, the Scholarship for the next academic year will not be awarded. However, scholarship will be restored (only prospectively) in the next academic year, provided the scholar's academic performance is within the aforesaid eligibility norm as mentioned above in (b).

ii) Fees

- a) A one-time payment **for first year** at UM-DAE CEBS is Rs. 22,100/- for general/OBC students and Rs. 19,600/- for reserved category (SC/ST/PD). However from **second year onward the yearly fees** at the UM-DAE CEBS for General/OBC category students is Rs. 7,800/- (Rupees seven thousand eight hundred only) while for reserved category (SC/ST/PD) it is Rs. 2,700/- (Rupees two thousand seven hundred only). In addition, premium for annual medical insurance of Rs. 850/- will have to be paid by all the students every year.
- b) Students should ensure that all fees and allied expenses such as hostel bill, mess bill etc. are settled on time.
- c) In case of non-payment of any dues, the Centre can withhold issuance of documents such as grade reports, degree certificate, leaving certificate, etc.
- d) If the payment of fees or other dues is delayed beyond the stipulated date, the Centre holds the right to take disciplinary action including barring the student from appearing for the examination.

iii) Selection of the major stream

- a) Maximum number of seats in any stream will be one third (rounded off to the next higher integer) of the total number of students qualifying for the second year (see below).
- b) At the beginning of the second year, every student will opt for a 'major' stream. Student should decide their choice by 20th July of the second year. The stream will be allotted based on the academic performance of students in that batch according to the CGPA during the first two semesters, and successful completion of prerequisite courses necessary for that stream. The decision of the Centre in this regard will be final and binding.
- c) Students who did not have Mathematics as a subject at +2 level, may take courses M100 and M200 instead of M101 and M201 in their first year. Those who did have Mathematics at +2 level, have to take M101 and M201 which are prerequisites for taking Mathematics / Physics streams in the second year. For the students who did not have Mathematics at +2 level, but want to take streams other than Biology and Chemistry, the prerequisites may be waived if they display competency in the course content by appearing for a qualifying examination. Remedial courses will be offered to students who have not opted for Biology in their 11th and 12th standard courses.

iv) Attendance

- a) Attendance in lectures, tutorials and laboratories is compulsory.
- b) If a student fails to have at least 85% attendance in any course, then an academic penalty will be imposed as per the guidelines in force.

v) Academic standards

- a) The course work for the first two semesters is common to students from all the streams and is compulsory.
- b) At the beginning of the second academic year, if a student has a CGPA less than 4.0 and/or has accumulated two or more F grades, then the student's enrollment in the programme and continuation at CEBS shall be terminated.
- c) At the beginning of the third academic year, if a student has a CGPA less than 4.0 and/or has accumulated two or more F grades, then the student's enrollment in the programme and continuation at UM-DAE CEBS shall also be terminated.
- d) At the beginning of the fourth academic year, if a student has a CGPA less than 4.0 and/or has accumulated two or more F grades, then the student's enrollment in the programme and continuation at CEBS shall be terminated. A B.Sc. degree, may be awarded, if the student fulfills the credit requirements.
- e) If a student fails in any course, one re-examination shall be permitted.

vi) Code of Conduct

The continuation of a student in the academic programme or in the hostel may be terminated if he / she involves himself / herself, in misconduct of any kind, found engaged in ragging, misbehavior, etc.

The rules may be amended from time to time and the student will have to abide by them.
